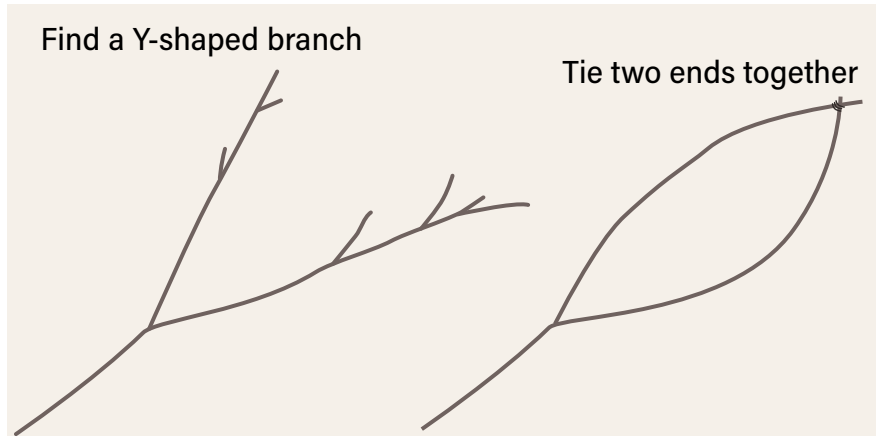


## Tips for creating inspirational spaces in your backyard

### MAKING WINGS

To make your wings, find two Y-shaped branches and tie their ends together to make your wing shape.

Decorate your wings using up-cycled textiles such as scraps of fabric, bits of ribbon and lace.



### MAKING A MINIATURE WORLD

To make your miniature world, have a look around the area that you're planning to work in. Look for small spaces that could be turned into a wee house or room such as the crook of a tree, a crevasse in a rock pile etc.

Once your space is decided, look for found objects that will fit into your miniature world such as acorn caps, feather, rocks etc. Old doll clothes work well for miniature close lines or you can sew your own!



### CONSIDERATIONS

Please stick to private property that you have permission to be on when creating your installation.

It's best to use natural materials that will decompose and not harm animals.

Be mindful not to harm the natural environment when gathering materials and creating your installations.
